



BOAT OWNER ADVISORY CHECKLIST

Effective 8/1/21

DEALER RESPONSIBILITIES:

- ✓ Dealer must rig and fully inspected the boat's operation and deem it to be water ready.
- ✓ Dealer must provide you and your family a hands-on orientation of your new boat, general operation guidelines and an overview of safety issues regarding the use of the vessel.
- ✓ Dealer must provide a complete owner's packet containing all printed manuals and/or electronic links and information regarding the boat and other components related to your purchase.
- ✓ Dealer must review all applicable warranties related to your purchase and will assist you in completing the online DocuSign boat warranty registration process and will provided instruction as to how to obtain future warranty service.

OWNER RESPONSIBILITIES:

- ✓ I understand that my dealer is to provide operating instructions for my new boat & motor. It is highly recommended that the orientation be hands-on and in-water, especially for those new to boating.
- ✓ I understand that boating safety courses are available and recommended before operation.
- ✓ I understand that I am required to have safety equipment on my boat that follows the guidelines set forth by the State in which the boat is operated. The dealer is not required to provide this equipment.
- ✓ I understand that all persons must be seated inside the railings while the boat is in motion.
- ✓ I understand that federal regulations require that all operators of boats under 26 feet must actually wear the engine cut off safety lanyard when operating the boat.
- ✓ I understand that **I MUST TURN OFF THE ENGINE ANYTIME THERE IS A PERSON IN THE WATER NEAR THE BOAT.**
- ✓ I understand that I should never operate my boat while under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- ✓ I understand that I should carry adequate personal liability and property damage insurance on my boat.
- ✓ I agree to render proper maintenance and periodic servicing of the boat, motor and components in accordance with manufacturer suggestions and maintenance requirements.
- ✓ I agree to familiarize myself and obey with all warning labels on the boat.
- ✓ If the boat is equipped with a ski tow bar, I understand that the ski tow bar must not be used for any other purpose other than towing a single person engaged in watersports.
- ✓ If the boat is equipped with a saltwater package, I understand it has components that make the boat more saltwater resistant but does not make the boat saltwater proof. ***Saltwater corrosion is excluded from coverage in Avalon and Tahoe's warranty. Please consult the care instruction in your owner's manual for more information on how to care for your boat when used in saltwater.*** Equipping the boat with dealer supplied antifouling paint is recommended.
- ✓ I have been advised that I should not transport my boat with the seat covers, mooring cover or playpen cover installed and that I use a "transom saver" to support the motor when trailering to prevent damage and to avoid the potential for transom weld fractures.
- ✓ I have been advised that I must not leave my Bimini top open (deployed) at speeds above 25MPH, either on the road or on the water, as this may damage the frame & cause injury.
- ✓ I have received a copy of my owner's manual which outlines basic operation, recommended cleaning procedures and approved cleaners to be used to clean the boat's furniture, canvas, flooring, etc.

I (we) acknowledge that I (we) have received, have had the opportunity to review and understand these advisories in their entirety.

I (we) have reviewed the terms of the Limited Warranty and accept the terms and conditions of this Limited Warranty.
